A great opportunity to meet other parents and for the children to make new friends.

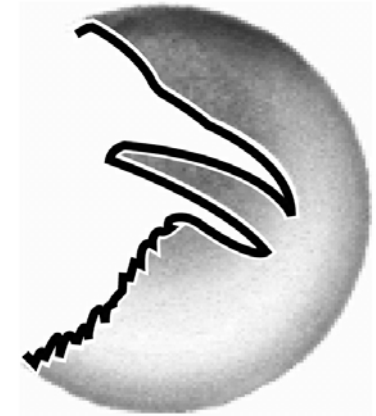
Information Sessions
